To the editor of the Patriot-News:

Your article on Friday March 9 on the Penn State Board of Trustees' February retreat was inaccurate, misleading, and filled with speculative comments by "experts" that didn't know the facts.

The Retreat of the Penn State Board of Trustees was not subject to the requirements that there be a "public meeting" under the Pennsylvania "Sunshine Law."

This is because, among other reasons, no official action was taken at the retreat, either with respect to committee restructuring or with respect to any other University business. Nor did any deliberations of University business take place at the retreat for the purpose of making any decisions, policy or otherwise.

In addition, the Board Retreat included consultation with attorneys and other advisors and training sessions for board members, which are permitted under the state Sunshine Law to be done in a closed session.
