I met with Dan Mc Ginn this past Thursday to discuss the University's relationship with the Paterno family. This note will summarize the agreed upon takeaways from our meeting:

- The Paterno family is concerned that the Freeh Report will paint Coach Paterno in an unflattering light.
- I told him that the report will be independent comprehensive and thorough.
- I also alluded to the possibility that we might insert a "reputable third party" to receive the report to make abundantly clear that the Board had no influence or control over the substance of the report.
- McGinn strongly urged us to do so and to communicate this intermediate step as soon as possible.
- He and Sollers will urge the family to reach out to Judge Freeh to provide interviews.
- McGinn agreed that the dispute over the Beaver Stadium box was "stupid" and "petty". He says he will urge the family to drop their objections to what has been offered.
- He says that he is urging temperance and moderation. (He has declined Oprah Winfrey's invitation to air the family's views on this matter.)
- He says that Scott is the most angry and "protective" of his mother, but that he can be reasoned with.
- Despite her anger over how the BOT treated her late husband, Mrs. Paterno wants a "resolution" that allows her to stay connected with the University and which "restores the honor of the Paterno name for her kids and grandkids".
- In this regard, he thinks an acknowledgement that Coach Paterno should have been given an opportunity to provide the BOT "his side of the story" would go a long way.

- McGinn will develop some ideas that might lead the two sides to "common ground" although he recognizes that the Freeh Report will likely be another difficult thing for the family to deal with.
- Dan and I agreed to keep open lines of communication.
