As we discussed this morning, when the child sex abuse allegations involving Jerry Sandusky hit the media last fall, there was considerable debate within the national office leadership regarding what, if anything, the NCAA should do. Some believe that charges of a lack of institutional control and/or unethical conduct should be made against Penn State and those who allegedly knew about the abuse. Others believed that the Association has no business "sticking its nose" into law enforcement matters. That debate is ongoing.

On that topic, attached is a letter primarily written by Donald, but under Mark Emmert's signature, that was sent to PSU's president shortly after the case broke.
