I told a USA Today reporter on Friday that Rod and Penn State faced a real risk of suspension of play even in the final consent decree until we determined not to include it in the actions announced. If Penn State rejected the consent decree and went through the enforcement process the death penalty would have been in play there. But, no one threatened anybody.
